Any vaccines not current or without proper documentation will need to be updated based on destination requirements before the health certificate can be issued. Some countries have a waiting period after vaccination before an animal can be admitted to the country.

Please note: our veterinarians retain the right to deny endorsement of a Health Certificate if all of the requirements have not been met. **It is the responsibility of the pet owner to obtain and provide information on all requirements and any necessary records.**

The health certificate process can be complicated and time consuming. Please contact the USDA for any questions or concerns you might have regarding this process.
